Subject: Minutes of Board Meeting

1. The Meeting was opened by President Vicki Edwards at 7:00 PM, at 9803 S. 21<sup>st</sup> Circle, Bellevue NE. With 2 of 3 directors present, a quorum of the Board existed.
2. Attendance at the Meeting included:

3. The minutes of the meeting held on 12 February 2026, were approved.
4. Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported the following status, as of 28 February 2026: First Interstate Bank Checking Account: \$37,492.33; Fidelity Money Market: \$65,603.34, for a total of \$103,095.67.
5. Finance Director's Report: The following items were discussed:
  - A. AI Cans for 2 X 4's: No new developments.
  - B. Church of Nativity Offering, Sat-Sun, 17-18 Jan 26: On 4 Mar 26, Bob Corsi requested that the Church of Nativity send a \$95,000 check to the ACC.
  - C. Offutt Base Chapel Offering, Sat-Sun, 7-8 Feb 26: A check for \$2,183.00 was received on 24 Feb 26. The Secretary submitted a thank you notice for the 1 March 2026 Catholic Chapel bulletin.
  - D. Bowl-a-thon, 3 PM, Sat 21 Mar 26: Nine (9) bowlers have signed up to participate with the Laski Family to provide an additional 9 to 11 bowlers. Chop's Bowl indicated that bowling will now start at 3:30 PM and that games and shoe rental need to be prepaid. Pledges collected to date: \$1,680.00.
  - E. 2026 Fundraising Financial Plan: Progress on the \$110,000 fundraising goal is at \$4,893 or 4.5%.
  - F. Other Ideas: None.
6. Old Business:
  - A. Update of Membership Roster: No new developments.
  - B. VA Connection (Bob Corsi): No new developments.
  - C. Crew Website ( <http://www.accrew.org> ): No new developments.
  - D. Colorado (CO) Connection (Corey Cinabro): Corey provided comments and suggestions for avoiding missing the nailing of the OSB and the siding buckling that occurred on the East end of the 2025 Tucker home.
  - E. Volunteer Recruitment in Bellevue: We had 6 Crew volunteers for the Fat Tuesday pancake dinner on 17 Feb 26, in the Capehart Chapel Annex. With the Secretary providing self-addressed and stamped envelopes, to 3 attendees who wanted to donate to the ACC, the Crew received a total of \$270.00. About thirty people attended this event.

F. 2026 Deployment (Work starts on Thurs, 28 May 26): The 10' X 8' storage shed from Lowe's in Somerset was delivered to the Mitchell Family home site on 24 Feb 26. On 5 Mar 26, the Forest Service approved the removal of trees around the storage shed concrete slab, which the Owner will take down. The on-site Crew list now shows 31 volunteers. Kathi Narlock has purchased the microwave and will donate it to the Crew for the Mitchell home.

G. 2025 Tucker Home, Buckling East End Siding: Jim Barney and the Holy Cross college students repaired the siding on 1 Mar 26, by replacing a portion of the unnailed and bowed OSB and then reinstalling the siding. Siding still shows a slight bow that will be reevaluated in May 26. Kay calls the siding bow minimal but indicated that Jim Barney is willing to repair siding again in Jul 26.

H. Crew Shirts: The Secretary picked up 6 shirts from JoDon's on 27 Feb 26 at a total cost of \$211.86 (\$33.00 each plus sales tax). The updated shirt inventory is now 2 M, 5 L and 3 XL.

#### 7. New Business:

A. Second Payment to Good Shepherd Chapel for the Mitchell Home: The Construction Director recommended that an additional \$20,000 payment be sent.

B. 2025 IRS Form 990-EZ on Website ([support@form990.org](mailto:support@form990.org)): The Treasurer completed this required annual form and paid the 990 Online Usage Fee (for annual receipts over \$100,000) of \$41.00 to the Civic Leadership Project,. The Website emailed the form to the IRS, and it was accepted on 5 Mar 26.

#### C. 2027 Deployment:

(1) Joshua and Kelsy Matthews picked up an application from Kay after first wrongly applying with the Church of Nativity.

(2) The Conflict in dates between the Crew Members Micah Petersen and Cassie Walker Wedding on 4 Jun 27 and deployment dates: The Secretary sent an email to Cassie explaining that the Crew could not changes the dates of deployment which would affect the personal schedules of 30 onsite volunteers and would require revising the Crew reservations at St. Joe's Inn without affecting other volunteer groups' schedules. Cassie did not respond to the Crew's email. However, with Head Cook Vicki Edwards considering going to Cassie's wedding, a replacement Head Cook could be necessary for 2027.

8. The Crew Meeting was adjourned at 7:34 PM. Our next Meeting is set for 7:00 PM, Thurs, 9 Apr 26, at 9803 S. 21<sup>st</sup> Circle.
